

Terms and Conditions of Sale – Collectible Coin

Effective Date: 17th June 2026

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern the purchase and sale of the collectible coin ("Product") to the purchaser ("you", "your").

By placing an order for the Product, you agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Product Description

The Product is a commemorative and collectible coin intended solely for collection, display, or gifting purposes.

Product Specifications

- Material: Die-cast zinc alloy
- Finish: Antique gold plating
- Design: Collectible Coin – Scotties in the City
- Dimensions: 35mm

The Product is not legal tender, currency, an investment product, financial instrument, or precious metal bullion product unless expressly stated otherwise.

Minor variations in colour, finish, texture, plating, engraving, packaging, dimensions, or appearance may occur during manufacturing and shall not constitute a defect.

2. Fair Distribution

To ensure fair distribution, purchases are limited to: One (1) Product per household.

A household is determined by one or more of the following:

- Delivery address;
- Billing address;
- Payment method;
- Any other information reasonably indicating multiple purchases by the same household.

We reserve the right to refuse multiple purchases where we reasonably believe they are being made on behalf of the same household.

3. Pricing and Payment

All prices are stated in Pounds Sterling (£) and include VAT where applicable unless otherwise stated.

4. Promotional Discounts and Reward Codes

Reward Code Promotion

Where offered, a discount may be applied in consideration of the supply of a valid reward code by the purchaser.

By submitting a reward code, you represent and warrant that:

- You are authorised to use the code;
- The code has been obtained lawfully;
- The code has not previously been redeemed where redemption is limited.

We reserve the right to:

- Verify eligibility;
- Refuse invalid, expired, duplicated, fraudulent, or unauthorised codes;
- Reverse discounts obtained through misuse;
- Cancel orders involving suspected fraud or abuse.

Reward codes:

- Have no cash value;
- Cannot be exchanged for cash;
- Cannot be combined with other promotions unless expressly stated;
- May be withdrawn or amended at any time.

5. Consumer Cancellation Rights

Where a purchaser has any statutory right to cancel under applicable consumer legislation, any returned Product must be unused, in its original condition and, where reasonably possible, returned with its original packaging.

Unless required by law, refunds or exchanges will not be provided for change of mind, accidental purchase, or dissatisfaction with the design, finish, appearance or perceived collectability of the Product.

6. Faulty, Damaged or Misdescribed Goods

Nothing in these Terms affects your statutory rights under:

- The Consumer Rights Act 2015;
- The Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008;
- Any other applicable consumer protection legislation.

If the Product is faulty, damaged, or not as described, please return to point of sale promptly.

Where legally required, we will provide repair, replacement, refund, or other remedies in accordance with your statutory rights.

7. Product Care and Safety

The Product is intended for display and collection purposes.

The Product:

- Is not a toy;
- Is not intended for children under 14 years of age;
- May contain small parts presenting a choking hazard.

You are responsible for ensuring safe storage and handling.

8. Intellectual Property

No intellectual property rights (including designs, artwork, logos, names) are transferred to you by purchasing the Product.

You may not reproduce, copy, manufacture, distribute, modify, or commercially exploit the Product design without prior written consent.

9. Limitation of Liability

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability where such exclusion or limitation would be unlawful, including liability for:

- Death or personal injury caused by negligence;
- Fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation;
- Breach of statutory consumer rights.

The Product has been manufactured and supplied to the charity by a third-party manufacturer. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the manufacturer, its directors, officers, employees and agents shall have no liability to any purchaser arising from or in connection with the Product, its sale, ownership or use.

10. Excluded Losses

To the fullest extent permitted by law, we shall not be liable for:

- Indirect losses;
- Consequential losses;
- Loss of profits;
- Loss of business;

- Loss of revenue;
- Loss of opportunity;
- Loss of goodwill;
- Loss of anticipated savings.

11. Collectible Value

We make no representation or warranty regarding:

- Future value;
- Resale value;
- Investment performance;
- Collectability;
- Scarcity;
- Market demand.

The Product is sold as a collectible item only.

Purchasers acknowledge that the Product is sold primarily as part of a charitable fundraising initiative. No representation is made that any portion of the purchase price reflects the intrinsic value of the materials used in the Product.

The Product is sold as a commemorative collectible. The charity does not guarantee that the Product will appreciate in value, retain value, achieve any particular resale price or remain available in future.

12. Maximum Liability

Subject to applicable law, the maximum aggregate liability of the charity, its trustees, employees, volunteers, agents and contractors shall not exceed the purchase price paid for the Product.

No trustee, volunteer, employee, representative or agent of the charity shall have any personal liability arising from the sale or supply of the Product.

13. Manufacturing Variations and Disclaimer

Due to the manufacturing process used in die-cast zinc alloy products with antique gold plating:

- Minor surface marks;
- Colour variations;
- Patina differences;
- Tooling marks;
- Edge variations;
- Plating irregularities;
- Packaging imperfections;

may occur and shall not be regarded as defects where they are consistent with normal manufacturing tolerances.

Variations between individual coins are an inherent characteristic of the manufacturing process and contribute to the collectible nature of the Product.

14. Severability

If any provision of these Terms is found to be unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

15. Entire Agreement

These Terms constitute the entire agreement between the parties relating to the purchase of the Product and supersede all prior discussions, representations, and understandings.

Except as required by law, the purchaser acknowledges that they have not relied upon any statement, representation or promise not expressly set out in these Terms.

16. Force Majeure

We shall not be liable for failure to supply the Product where such failure results from circumstances beyond our reasonable control.

17. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms shall be governed by the laws of Scotland. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Terms shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Scottish courts, except where mandatory consumer protection laws provide otherwise.

18. Limited Edition and Availability

The Product is produced in limited quantities. We reserve the right to withdraw the Product from sale at any time without liability. Availability is not guaranteed and no contract for sale is formed until payment has been accepted and the Product has been supplied to the purchaser.

The charity reserves the right to refuse any sale, cancel any reservation, or decline to supply the Product where it reasonably believes these Terms have been breached or where supply would be contrary to the purposes of the fundraising initiative.

The decision of the charity regarding eligibility for any discount or reward code shall be final.

The charity reserves the right to amend, suspend or discontinue the fundraising initiative or any associated promotion at any time without liability.
